This seminar is relevant to new and existing teachers of Senior Cycle RSE. It will outline curriculum content covering relationships, sexuality, sexual health, STIs, fertility and contraception. Best practice teaching, learning and assessment methodologies will be explored to develop teacher confidence in addressing sensitive issues with students. Participants will be offered guidance on the use of the TRUST lesson pack and other sanctioned resources.
